Item I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Baker my share of the Mill property purchased by me at sheriff sale and which was sold by Joshua Garwood on account of James J Baker on condition that he the said Joseph Baker pay off a certain mortgage which James English holds against the mills property I do order and request the obligations I hold against my sons to be given up to them.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Baker Doughty a certain Survey of eighty two acres adjoining the Cotton Survey

Item I give and bequeath unto Thomas Ayres and his wife and to their heirs and assigns forever all that place or farm on which the said Ayres now resides

Item I devise unto my son Daniel Baker Jr the share of the beach which was sold by Joshua Garwood Sheriff on account of James J Baker and purchased by me

Item I order the residue of my debts to be paid out of my personal property and the balance that shall be left of said personal estate I give and bequeath to my two daughters Mary Somers and Hannah C Grimes to be equally divided between them

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Somers and her husband Jesse Somers Jr and unto my daughter Hannah Ann C Grimes and her husband Barton Grimes the residue of all the lands purchased by me at Sheriff sale sold on account of James J Baker to be divided between my daughters and their husbands share and share alike

Asst I hereby appoint my son Daniel Baker Jr Executor of this my last will and testament signed sealed published and declared
