I James Baremore of the Township of Galloway in the County of Atlantic and state of New Jersey being of sound mind memory and understanding do make and publish this my last Will and testament in manner following that is to say

First It is my will and I do order that all my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be after my decease

Second I give and devise unto my son Daniel Baremore the use of all my Beach to the North East of Adams survey on Brigantine Beach during his natural life and after his decease I give and devise the said Beach to his three sons Joab Baremore Benjamin Baremore and Jacob Baremore to be equally divided between them to them and their heirs and assigns forever

Third I give and devise unto my two grand sons George Smith and Benjamin Baremore all my right to the Oyster flats in wegin Bay to be equally divided between them to them and their heirs and assigns forever

Fourth I give and devise unto my grand son Henry D Smith all the residue of my Beach which lies to the south West of the North part of Adams survey aforesaid including the Buildings and improvements subject to the payment of fifty Dollars to my son Daniel Baremore in six months after my decease and I do hereby give the said sum of fifty dollars to my said son Daniel Baremore and charge the said Beach with the payment thereof to him his heirs and assigns forever

Fifth I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Sooy the one half part of all the money on hand and debts due and owing at the time of my decease to her and her heirs forever and the other half part thereof I give and bequeath unto my two grand sons James Baremore and David Baremore sons of Thomas Baremore deceased to be equally divided between them to them and their heirs forever

Sixth I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Sooy all the residue of my personal estate to her and her heirs forever
