Sooy Richard Sooy Samuel Sooy and Benjamin Sooy, and Elizabeth Blakeman and Sophia Doughty my two daughters and their heirs and assigns forever a tract of salt and sedge Meadows adjoining lands of Joab on the North East and adjoining lands of Clark Endicott on the South West and binding Tanners Brook Creek on the North and West

5<sup>th</sup> I give and devise to my son Richard Sooy his heirs and assigns the right and privilege to move his house off the ground where it now stands

6<sup>th</sup> My request is that if my son Benjamin Sooy dies a minor and without any lawful heir or heirs in such case all I have left him in the former articles of this will is to be my son Richard Sooy his heirs and assigns forever

And Lastly I nominate and appoint my son Richard Sooy to be Executor to this my last will and testament
