Webber and Rachel Seamen share and share alike

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Jeremiah Kisley and David B. Somers executors of this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 14th. day of June A.D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty 1860
