

315 Will of Uriah Gandy

In the name of God Amen I Uriah Gandy of the Township of Weymouth in the County of Atlantic and state of New Jersey being of sound mind memory and understanding (for which blessing I thank God) do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say.

First It is my will and I do order that all my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be after my decease.

Item I give bequeath and devise unto my beloved wife Margaret (so long as she remains my widow) all of my estate both real and personal whatsoever and wheresoever situate during her natural life or widowhood as aforesaid and at her death or marriage to descend to my son J. B. Richardson Gandy his heirs and assigns forever.

Lastly I hereby appoint my loving wife Margaret Gandy executrix of this my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty four
