Will of John Giberson Sen.

In the name of God Amen I John Giberson Sen of the
Township of Galloway County of Atlantic State of New
Jersey being of sound mind memory and under-
standing (for which blessing I thank God) do make
and publish this my last will and testament in
manner following that is to say,

First It is my will and I do order that all my just
debts and funeral expences be duly paid and satis-
fied as soon as conveniently can be after my decease,
Item I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin
Giberson all the remaining part of the plantation
on which I now live not heretofore deced to my
son John D. Giberson deced agreeble to the line now
settled between them with all the building and
improvements thereon also seven acres purchased
by me of Evi Smith adjoining my other lands also
I give and bequeath to son Benjamin a tract of
cedar swamp containing four acres surveyed to Noah
Smith on the southerly side of Swan Bay Swamp I
also bequeath unto my son Benjamin forty five acres
surveyed to David Clark and Daniel Moore adjoining
to the West side of the one hundred and twenty four acres
I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Giberson
all of my half of a survey of fifty acres of Cedar Swamp

and Meadow Surveyed to Evi Smith agreeble to the
division line between the heirs of Augustus Sooy deced
Richard Bowen and myself the same being the Easterly
half of said survey, I do also give and bequeath to my
son Benjamin Giberson a tract of upland containing
six acres adjoining lands of Dr. Parcer & others which
I purchased of Absolum Steelman
Item Second All of the aforesaid mentioned tracts and
parcels of land herein bequeathed to my son Benjamin
Giberson I give & bequeath to him during the term of
his natural life and then it is my will and I do give
and bequeath the same to his lawful heirs, provided my
son Benjamin Giberson does punctually after my decease
pay unto my four daughters the sum - two hundred
dollars in the manner following viz, fifty dollars to my
daughter Susan Horner fifty dollars to Mary Cooley fifty
dollars to Esther Ann Cox and fifty dollars to Sarah Giberson
and in case my son Benjamin shall neglect or refuse
to pay over unto my four daughters before named the
aforesaid sum of two hundred dollars as herein before
directed for the space of four years after my decease
then it is my will and I do order and direct my Executors
herein after named to sell and dispose of so much of my
son Benjamin's share of the Real estate given him as
shall be necessary to raise the sum of two hundred dollars
and to pay the sum over to my four daughters as before
mentioned viz, fifty dollars to each of them,
Item third I give and bequeath the proceeds arising
from the sale of my personal property (which is hereby
directed to be sold at public sale) to my four daughters
before named to be equally divided between them and
I hereby order & direct my Executors to pay the sum or
sums of money arising from the sale of my personal prop-
erty as aforesaid to my said four daughters share and share
alike,
Lastly I do hereby appoint my two sons Richard Giberson
and Benjamin Giberson Executors to this my testament
and last will hereby revoking any and all others heretofore
by me made.
