 shall ultimately have as his portion one half of my
 estate not otherwise bequeathed and I direct my execu-
 tors to make or pay over to him after he becomes of age
 (21 years) from time to time such part or parts of said
 portion as they shall deem advisable until he shall
 have received the whole of said portion, but they shall
 not unwisely or unjustly delay or withhold payment
 to him in part or in full as the case may be,

It is my wish that my dear adopted daughter Mary Jane
 should, when she shall have arrived of age or shall
 begin the world for herself have out of my estate such
 outfit of clothing, furniture &c, as my executors shall
 deem proper considering all circumstances,
 I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary A. all my
 household furniture and all of my estate not herein
 otherwise disposed of,

I nominate and appoint my devoted wife Mary A. Smith
 and my brother John S. Smith to be executors of this my
 last will and testament,
