Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Brown wife of John Brown the sum of one thousand dollars in Cash,

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Charlotte Moore widow of James Moore deceased the sum of one thousand dollars in Cash to her and hers forever,

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Ann Walters wife of J. H. Waters the sum of one thousand dollars by her taking the note which her husband J. H. Waters gave to Ezra Price and the said Price assigned the same to me which note bears date the 20th December 1865. at Philadelphia and I do hereby order my Executors to pay the amount of said note to the said Ezra Price when Settled up,

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Susannah Price wife of Ezra Price the sum of one thousand dollars in Cash to her and hers forever, And it is my will and I do order that after paying the aforementioned Legacys if there is any balance left I do order it to be divided equally between my son Daniel C. Frambes and my six daughters share and share alike I do hereby order my Executors to sell the tract of wood land above Derestus B. Steelmans and adjoining Enoch Sculls either at public or private sale to the best advantage and take the proceeds to pay out as aforementioned,




