On the Matter of the probate of the Alleged will of Hattie A Crosby deceased. Order for probate

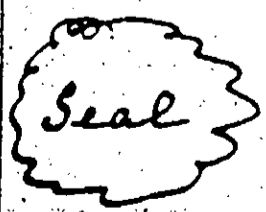

Will of Job Adams

I Job Adams in the name of God Amen, of Township of Egg Harbour County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey having taken into consideration the uncertainty of life while in health and rite reason of mind do think proper to make this my last will and testament in the following manner.

- 1st I give and bequeath to my Wife Rebecca two thousand dollars in cash with lot of ground two and half acres all the Buildings with the store and that should be in it at my Death and all the moveable property and fire wood of my property as long she liveth.
2nd I give to my son Even M. Adams two acres of land running from the shore road a strate line to James R. Adams line across Daniel J. Bartlett's line to his own line with one lot upland and meadow running from Daniel Adams lane to lane on the south side 2 acres more or less with being a lot with fell to of my father at his death 2 acres more or less below the railrode of meadow 2 acres of wood land being a part of 20 acres of my father with fell to me at his Death ruing from Daniel Adams line between peter Adams and Elisha Adams running running across the fire road up to the head of the line to him his heirs and assigns.
3rd I give to Even M. Adams and John M. Adams my sons the tract of land that I Bought of Robert B. Leeds fifteen acres more or less to be equally divided between them to there their heirs and assigns
4th I give to my three Daughters Miranda Risley Loezar Casto Rebecca Stibs four hundred Dollars each to them their heirs and assigns.
5th I give to Abigail Adams the daughter of Even M. Adams sum of fifty Dollars to her and heirs and assigns
6th I give to Job Adams my grand son my Buildings and lot of 2 1/2 acres when we shall dead to live to him his heirs and assigns
7th I leave Sixty Dollars for tomb stones for me and my wife Rebecca and our funeral expenses to be paid out of my personal property
8th I give my two daughters each Loezar and Rebecca of one D when we are done with them. And I give what I have to Even M. Adams John M. Adams Loezar and Rebecca Stibs my sons and Daughters All the
