

taxes on the house and lot in Camden N.J. and keep the same in good repair, so long as she remains my widow, and if she does not see proper to reside there herself she is to receive the rents issues and profits therefrom.

Item - It is my will and I do order that my Executrix hereinafter named shall have power to sell and dispose of any of my personal property as she may deem best for my Estate, either at private or public sale.

Item - I give and bequeath unto my said wife and children viz: Sarah R. Deviney, Caroline J. Deviney, Walter S. Deviney and Frederick J. Deviney the balance of all my real and personal property whatsoever and wheresoever situate, consisting of furniture household goods, Insurance money, Rail Road stock, Bonds and mortgages, Cash in Bank, or whatever I may have on hand at the time of my decease into four equal parts share and share alike to them and their heirs and assigns forever.

Lastly I hereby appoint my loving wife Sarah R. Deviney Executrix of this my last will and testament.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Seventh day of June A.D. 1881.
