

# Will of Jane Roy

In the Name of God Amen!

I Jane Roy of Hammoniton Atlantic County State of New Jersey do hereby make and publish this my last will and Testament, as follows.

First. - I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my executor as soon after my decease as possible.

Second. - I give devise and bequeath all my Real Estate whatsoever and wheresoever unto my sister Victoria wife of Augustin Morlot for her natural life and at her death to be rented and the proceeds to be used for the clothing of her three children namely, Mary Ellen Morlot, Francis Margaret Morlot and Augustin Antide Morlot until the youngest attain the age of twenty one years and then to them and their heirs forever in equal parts as tenants in Common.

I also give to my sister Victoria Morlot all my personal estate including my clothing to have and to hold forever.

Third. - I appoint my sister Victoria Morlot my executor of this my will. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty first day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight Hundred and seventy three.


