Will of David Williams

In the name of God, Amen. I David Williams of the town-
ship of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New
Jersey being of sound mind memory and understanding (for
which blessing I thank God) do make and publish this my
last will and testament in manner following that is to say,
First - It is my will and I do order that all my just debts
and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as
conveniently can be after my decease.

Item - I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Delila Ann
Williams in addition to her right-of-dower at common law the
use of all my real and personal property of every kind and de-
scription as long as she remains my widow.

Item - I give and bequeath to my daughter Lydia Ann Jago
one acre of land on the north-west-side of the shore road and
adjoining Sylvester Robinson's land that he now lives upon.

Item - I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Elizabeth
Paul one acre of land binding on the north west side of the
shore road and the south west side of the new road leading

from the shore road to the bog road making a corner lot.

Item - I give and bequeath to my son David Williams One acre of land
situate on the east-side of the bog road and along the road leading from
the shore road to the bog road also to my son David Williams.
I give and bequeath one acre of land fronting on the shore road together
with the dwelling house upon it now standing after the decease of my wife
Delila Ann Williams.

Item - I have given to my sons John B. Williams and Thomas M. Williams
deeds for one acre of land to each of them situate on the south east-
side of the shore road as their portion compared with what I have
given to my other children by will as above mentioned and located.

Item - It is my will and desire that after the decease of my widow
the remainder of my real and personal estate shall be divided betw-
een my heirs share and share alike. Of this my last will and testament
Signed published and declared by the said
David Williams to be his last will in the
presence of us who were present at the
same time and subscribed our names
as witnesses in the presence of the testator,
