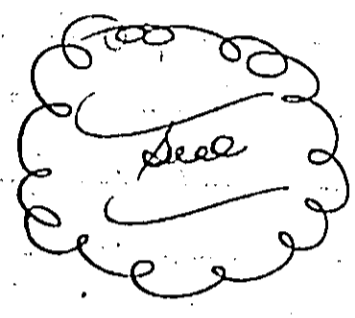

In the name of God, Amen, I, Hermann Walter, of Galloway Township in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, being of sound mind, memory and understanding, but of feeble health do make Ordain, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, that is to say:

Firstly; I do order that all my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be after my decease.

Secondly; I give bequeath and devise unto my beloved nephew Martin Schade all my property and estate, both real and personal, wheresoever situated or whatsoever the same may be, of which I may die seized or possessed, unto him and his heirs and assigns forever.

Lastly I hereby appoint my said nephew Martin Schade Executor of this my said last will and testament.
