

South westerly and parallel to Davis and Webb Division line One Hundred feet to the Division line between Davis and Holdphum to a corner then in the last named division line north westerly fifty feet to the beginning be the same more or less maintaining fifty feet in width at a right angle

I give to my Son Joseph H. Davis to him his heirs and assigns a lot or piece of land beginning at the South west cor of the lot devised to Peter Davis Childre and fifty feet from my cor in Webb's line Thence in Davis and Holdphum's line southerly for a distance of fifty feet thence between parallel lines with the Webb line northeasterly for a distance of One Hundred Feet each line maintaining between lines fifty feet at a right angle.

I give to my Daughter Alice Clifford - wife of William Clifford to her heirs and assigns a lot of land beginning at the southerly corner of my land whereon now resides her to William Hammeiland Thence bounding in Davis and Hammeil's line northerly One Hundred feet Thence at a right angle fifty feet to a corner Thence parallel to the first line southerly One Hundred feet more or less to my West line Thence in the division line last mentioned southerly fifty feet to the beginning

I give to my beloved wife Phoebe Ann Davis during her natural life the use of my farm and dwelling house also the use of all my personal property for her support and at her death I give to my son Daniel Davis all my real and personal estates of every kind which includes all which was willed to my wife during her natural life passing the Bill of her last sickness and Burial Out of hand estate to him and his heirs and assigns forever if Daniel Davis shall decease before his mother Phoebe Ann Davis then the said property is to go to his children
