

Fourth:- I give and bequeath the sum of Five thousand dollars to a Trust company in the City of Philadelphia to be selected and named by the then Executor of this my will hereinafter named, in trust to invest the same and keep the same invested in good securities and to pay the interest income and dividends therefrom as they shall accrue from time to time to my niece Elizabeth Winslow wife of Henry Winslow. And after the death of my said niece Elizabeth Winslow further in trust to assign and pay over the said principal sum of Five thousand dollars with its increment unto Marion Quincy Winslow daughter of said Elizabeth Winslow, if she be then living, or to her children if she be dead leaving children her surviving. And if the said Marion Quincy shall not survive her mother, and shall not leave children her surviving, then further in trust to assign and pay the said principal sum with its increment to the children of my said niece Elizabeth Winslow who shall then be living, share and share alike.

Fifth: I give and bequeath the sum of Three thousand dollars to my niece Rebecca Waln Remington for the use of her children.

Sixth: I wish to record here that inasmuch as I have made other provision for my dear niece Lucy Dyer, I have not named her as a legatee in this my Will.

Seventh:- I give and bequeath the sum of Three hundred dollars to each of my nephews, Thomas S. Kempton, Ignace O. Kempton and Augustus W. Kempton.

Eighth:- I give and bequeath the sum of Five hundred dollars to my niece Elizabeth Ryers Blight.

Ninth:- I give and bequeath the sum of Five hundred dollars to my friend Margaret (Rita) Thouron.

Tenth:- I give and bequeath the sum of One thousand dollars to my mother's maid Ellen Rogan.

Eleventh:- I give and bequeath the sum of Three thousand dollars to the most Reverend Patrick J. Ryan Roman Catholic Archbishop of Philadelphia or to his successor in office to be equally distributed by him, to "The House of the Good Shepherd" and "Saint Vincent's Home" charities under his care.

Twelfth:- Inasmuch as by his last Will and testament duly executed, my dear Husband has devised and bequeathed to me certain Real Estate and premises situate at No. 1114 North Third Street in the City of Philadelphia, and certain other Real Estate

situate at Richfield Springs in the State of New York, now, if at the time of my death I shall be the owner, or entitled to said premises under the devise aforesaid, I order and direct the then Executor of this my will, to sell both of said premises; and out of the proceeds of the premises No. 1114 North Third Street, I give and bequeath the sum of Five hundred dollars to Joseph A. Donnelly junior son of Theodore J. Donnelly; the sum of Five hundred dollars to Henry W. Taylor son of Clara W. Taylor; the sum of One thousand dollars to the most Reverend Patrick J. Ryan Roman Catholic Archbishop of Philadelphia or to his successor in office for masses for the repose of the souls of my husband and myself; and the residue and remainder of the net proceeds of said sale I give and bequeath to the said Most Reverend the Roman ^{Catholic} Archbishop of Philadelphia for distribution among such of the Roman Catholic charities under his charge as he shall select. And I further Will and direct that of the proceeds of the premises at Richfield Springs, I give and bequeath two thirds of the net proceeds thereof to Ellen Rogan heretofore named in Tenth of this my Will, and the remaining one third to the Reverend John J. Ferry for the church of Saint Antony of Padua in Philadelphia.

Thirteenth:- All the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate I give devise and bequeath to my dear Husband absolutely, and if he shall not be living at the time of my death I give devise and bequeath the said rest, residue and remainder to the Executor or Executors of his last Will and testament to be received and taken by him or them as a part of his Estate, and distributed according to the terms and directions of his last Will and testament.

Lastly:- I appoint my husband Joseph A. Donnelly to be the Sole Executor of this my last Will and testament; and upon his death or in case of his inability or refusal to act, I appoint my nephew Clifford S. Kempton to be the Executor of this my Will.

And I do expressly provide and direct that neither of the said named Executors of this my will shall be required, or called upon to enter or give any security whatever for the faithful discharge of their duties as such Executors notwithstanding any custom or requirement of the law to the contrary; and I further direct that the details and specific items of the bequest to my husband of household furniture wearing apparel watch jewelry pictures &c.
