

I Elizabeth Gallagher, of the City of Philadelphia, widow, do make and publish this to be my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time heretofore made.

Item. I direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as possible.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary King all of my household goods and effects except my piano. I also give her my watch and chain and my burglar proof safe.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Tillit wife of John Tillit my watch

Item. I give and bequeath my face and watch unto my grandson, James King.

Item. I give and bequeath the policy of life insurance upon the life of John Tillit and abeth Tillit.

Item. I give and bequeath my piano unto my grand daughter Lizzie King.

Item. I direct that my Executrices shall sell all my stock, fixtures, horse, carriage, wagon etc. and everything appertaining to my business and out of the proceeds to pay to my daughter Mary King the sum of One thousand dollars, and to my son, William Gallagher the sum of Seven hundred dollars and to my grandson William Gallagher, he being the son of my deceased son John Gallagher, the sum of one hundred dollars and to my grand daughter Mary J. Burtwhistle the sum of one hundred dollars.

Item. Any residue of my personal estate I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Tillit.

Item. I give and devise all of my real estate unto my daughter Mary King to hold to her for, and during the term of her natural life or while she remains single and unmarried, she however to pay the sum of Fifty dollars per annum during her enjoyment of such real estate unto such church as she may designate for the purpose of saying masses for myself and my late husband and provided also that my said daughter Mary King shall pay the premiums up to January 1st A.D. 1897 upon a certain policy of life insurance upon the life of John Tillit which I have bequeathed as above to my daughter Elizabeth

Tillit. These payments to be a charge upon the life interest of my said daughter Mary King in said real estate.

Item. After the death or marriage of my daughter Mary King I give and devise all of my real estate unto the Equine Saving Fund, and Trust Company of Philadelphia, their successors and assigns. In Trust to sell the said real estate either at public or private sale for the best price that can be obtained for the same and to execute and deliver to the purchaser or purchasers thereof goods and sufficient deed or deeds therefor free and clear of all trusts and without any liability on the part of such purchaser or purchasers to see to the applications, non-application or misapplication of the purchase money and the proceeds thereof to be by them invested and the net income thereof to be used for the support and maintenance of my two grand children Elizabeth King and James King until the youngest of them becomes twenty one years of age when the whole of the principal of said trust estate is to be distributed by my said trustee as follows:

One-half thereof to be paid to my two grand children Elizabeth King and James King in equal shares one quarter thereof to be paid to my son William Gallagher, and the remaining and other one quarter of said estate is to be retained by my said trustee and the same to be kept invested and the net income thereof to be paid to my daughter Elizabeth Tillit for, and during the term of her natural life and after her death then the principal of said trust estate being the remaining one-fourth of the original estate, I direct shall be paid to the children of said Elizabeth Tillit so that each one shall receive an equal share.

Item. I nominate constitute and appoint my two daughters Mary King and Elizabeth Tillit to be the Executrices of this my last will and testament.
