

their births and deaths respectively; said monu-
ment shall not exceed in cost the sum of one
thousand dollars, which sum of one thousand
dollars hereby appropriate for that specific pur-
pose.

Third: I give to my cousin J. Morton Red-
streak, one thousand dollars which sum of one
thousand dollars I hereby appropriate for that
specific purpose from my personal estate or from
the proceeds thereof.

Fourth: The rest, residue and remainder
of my property and estate, both real and personal
including the premises where I now live with
the lot and house and the furniture of every
description, I give to my dearly beloved wife Fannie
F. Chapman, her heirs and assigns forever and I
hereby direct and declare that the devise so as
afore said made to my said wife shall be by her re-
ceived in lieu of dower.

Fifth: I do give to my executor, hereinafter
named, full power and authority to grant, bargain
sell and convey any or all of my estate both real
and personal (except the house and lot herebefore
divided to my said wife Fannie F. Chapman) to any
person or persons in fee simple or otherwise at public or
private sale, at such times and upon such terms
and in such manner as to him shall seem meet.

Sixth: I hereby nominate and appoint
Elias Wright of Atlantic City, New Jersey, execu-
tor of this my last will and testament.
