

And I do order and direct that after the payment of my funeral expenses, and just debts the two legacies above mentioned and the above mentioned devises and bequests to my three daughters, that all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate whatsoever and wheresoever Real and Personal both that which I hold in my own right and that over which I have the power of limitation and appointment shall be divided in to three equal parts; And one of the said equal third parts of my Estate and that over which I have a power of limitation and appointment, I give devise bequeath limit and appoint unto my said daughter Lydia B. Wood wife of John B. Wood her heirs executors administrators and assigns to and for her and their only proper use and behoof forever.


And as to one other of the said equal third parts of my Estate and of that over which I have the power of limitation and appointment; I give devise and bequeath limit and appoint the same unto my said daughter Mary Ann Collins her heirs executors administrators and assigns to and for her and their only proper use and behoof forever.

And as to the remaining third part of my Estate and of that over which I have the power of limitation and appointment, I give devise bequeath limit and appoint the same unto my said daughter Margaret B. Wistar wife of Edward Wistar her heirs executors administrators and assigns to and for her and their only proper use and behoof forever.

Lastly, I nominate constitute and appoint The Provident Life and Trust Company of Philadelphia to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament.

And now in conclusion I desire to say with reverent thankfulness to that God who has kept me all my life long, to whose bounty I have owed the inheritance I now transmit to my children, I commit them and theirs unto that holy keeping which can guard them from all evil and will through the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ preserve them unto the end.
