Samson; The house, its contents of every name and nature whatsoever is given to Lida B. Samson I also give to Lida B. Samson the sum of nineteen hundred and sixty dollars in money also the three shares which I have invested in my name in the Hammonton Loan and Building Association all the residue of my estate named or not named, I give to my daughter Lida B. Samson I also give to Lida B. Samson the other undivided half of my land in Berlin, Camden County New Jersey I also give to Lida B. Samson

If either of my daughters becomes a party to any proceeding to interfere with this my last will and testament, the provision in this will in her favor is to be cancelled, and the whole estate in that event will go to the other heir - as I am out of debt and owe nothing to any one, I recommend that my two daughters shall submit this my will to proper proof according to the laws of the state of New Jersey and then divide the estate, as it is willed, between them, without expense or legal nonsense, they can ask advice. but I request them, to be their own executors. and I hereby so appoint them In witness whereof, I have hereunto subscribed my name, and affixed my seal, the eighth day of November, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and Eighty six
