

Seventh: To my son in law Adolphus F. Kappella I give and bequeath unto him the sum of five dollars.

Eighth: To my Grandson Adolphus Somers Kappella to him, his heirs and assigns the lot of land I purchased of our Mr. Morse, near the Baptist Church, situate in the Borough of Somers Point, Atlantic County, State of New Jersey, I also give unto him the sum of three hundred dollars in cash.

Ninth: To my Granddaughter Florence Hayday, I give and bequeath unto her, her heirs and assigns, one white China tea pot, and sugar bowl, with blue flowers on them.

And to my Granddaughter Lulu Hayday I give and bequeath unto her, and her heirs and assigns, one pair of sugar tongs, and one desert spoon.

Tenth: I give and devise unto my Grandson Richard Somers Anderson, his heirs and assigns lot No 295 in Section A. on the plan of lots of the "Ocean City Association" in Cape May County, State of New Jersey.

Eleventh: I do further order and direct, that all of my table linning, napkins, bedding, blankets, sheets, quilts, counterpane, covers, together with the balance of my dishes, that have not been heretofore bequeathed, to be equally divided between Richard B. Somers, Hannah S. Hayday, Deborah Jane Anderson, Florence I. Scull and Lucian B. Somers, share and share alike.

Twelfth: The residue and remainder of all of my lands and tenements, goods and chattels not herein disposed off: I order and direct that they be sold at public sale, and after paying all of my just debts, funeral expenses, and tombstones erected to my memory, the remainder to be equally divided between Richard B. Somers, Hannah S. Hayday, Deborah Jane Anderson, Florence I. Scull, Lucian B. Somers, and Adolphus Somers Kappella, share and share alike. Lastly, I hereby appoint George Hayday my son in law, the sole executor of this my last will and testament.
