


and empower each and every one of them, immediately after my decease, to take back the said moneys, and to have and hold the same forever.

6. I give and devise the house and lot in Egg Harbor City, situate on the north-west side of London Avenue, beginning at a point one hundred and sixty feet South westerly of Agate Street, being Eighty feet front on London Avenue, by one hundred and fifty feet deep, to my son, Jacob Seelig, to him, his heirs and assigns forever, provided that he shall support and maintain Elizabeth Edelmann Stuehrer of Egg Harbor City, for the balance of her natural life according to her actual wants and station in life.

7. I give and devise all the real and personal property of which I may die seized, except as herein before stated, to my husband, John Seelig, for and during his natural life, and upon his death, I give all the residue and remainder to my three sons, Jacob Seelig, Louis Seelig, and Fritz Seelig, in equal portions, share and share alike. And I hereby give power to my executor hereinafter named to sell and convey the said real and personal property, either at public or private sale, and to execute deeds of conveyance in fee simple or otherwise, for the same or any part thereof, to the purchaser or purchasers.

Lastly: I hereby appoint my son, Jacob Seelig Executor of this my last will and Testament.
