And it is my express desire and wish and I do hereby request my said wife Salley to care for and provide for my said daughters Jane and Lydia for and during the full term and period of her natural life.

Sixth, I do hereby constitute and appoint my said wife Salley to be guardian of both the persons and estates of any minor children I may leave at the time of my decease.

Seventh, I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said wife Salley to be sole executrix of this my last Will and Testament and I do authorize and empower my said Executrix to sell and dispose of any or all of my real estate and by good and sufficient deed or deeds to grant and convey the same to the purchaser or purchasers thereof in fee simple and without any liability on the part of the purchaser or purchasers of such real estate to see to the application of the purchase money.
