

part of my residuary estate.

Fourth, I give and bequeath unto Emma S. English, wife of David B. English, the bond and mortgage that I hold against William Force.

Fifth, all the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal, I direct to be sold by my executor, and out of the proceeds thereof, to pay all my just debts including funeral expenses, and whatever balance there may then remain, after the payment of said debts, and the expenses incurred in the settlement of my estate, I give and bequeath unto David B. English and Georgiana Payne, to be equally divided between them, share and share alike.

Sixth, I hereby nominate and appoint David B. English sole executor of this my last will and testament, and direct that he be not required to give bonds for the execution of the trust hereby reposed in him as such executor. I also direct and hereby empower him to sell my estate mentioned in the fifth paragraph of this my will, either at public or private sale as he may deem best, and to execute good and sufficient conveyance in law for the same, and that for the due execution of the same, he be given the period of two years from my decease.

In witness whereof, I, the said Sarah Smith, have hereunto set my hand and seal and subscribed my name this eleventh day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine.
