Pleibel absolutely and in fee And further I authorize and empower my Executors hereinafter named whenever they shall deem it for the best interests of my estate and in order to carry out the provisions of my Will to sell all or any part thereof either at public or private sale for the best price that can be obtained for the same and the proceeds again to invest in good and marketable securities giving the purchaser or purchasers thereof good and sufficient deeds therefor without any liability on the part of such purchaser or purchasers to see to the application of the purchase money thereof and

Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint Charles H. Kline of said City of Philadelphia and my niece Caroline L. Pleibel the Executors and Trustees of this my last Will and Testament.
