


Will of Mary S. Bordery.

In the Name of God. Amen.

I, Mary S. Bordery of the Town of Absecon in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, Being of sound mind, memory and understanding do make publish and declare this present writing as and for my last will and testament - viz - I hereby nominate and appoint Joel A. Tilton Executor of this my last will and testament. To my Son-in-law Joseph H. Edwards the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars and if not living at the death of the testator then the One hundred and fifty dollars to be paid to his Daughter Sarah D. Edwards. To my niece Susan B. Price and her heirs I give One Feather Bed Bolster and pillows, set of White Bed curtains, My Daughters portrait with other photographs one mirror that is in my Bed Room and Fifty Dollars in Cash. - To My Niece Mary Ann Walters to her and her heirs Twenty-five Dollars in money. To my Niece Martha B. Brown One Upholstered Rocking Chair and Twenty-five Dollars in money. - To my Niece Charlotte R. Moore Ten Dollars in money. - To my Nephew David B. Frankes Ten Dollars in money. - To my Niece Mariat L. Tilton to her and her heirs The Clock in my Bed Room One Brass Kettle and ten Dollars in money. - To my Nephew Warren P. Tilton I give one cherry Table. - To my Sister Susan T. Smith to her and her heirs I give my sofa-carpet on the bed room and one work stand. - To Amanda Robinson (Widow of Wesley Robinson) the portrait of her Uncle Jacob Somers and One Small Clock (Metallic) One Samples & Frame and my Family Bible. - To Mariah B. Steelman (Wife of John R. Steelman) to her and her heirs One bedstead used by myself, the window shades up and down stairs a stove standing in the cellar and Ten Dollars in money. - To Barrie R. Steelman I give my Small Rocking Chair and the carpet in my Back Bed Room. - To Thomas Doughty who was apprenticed to Jacob and Mary Somers to him & his heirs the Sum of Twenty-five Dollars in money. The remainder of my Household goods and Furniture (Excepting the Extension table) I do order my Executor to Divide or Sell as He may Elect and to Distribute one Half of the Same to Susan T. Smith and her heirs and the other Half to the children of my deceased Sister late Louisa Frankes viz: Charlotte Moore, Martha B. Brown, Mary A. Walters, Susan B. Price and David B. Frankes. - To Joel A. Tilton my trusty friend and Executor I give my Extension Table he to inherit the residue and remainder of my Estate of Every kind wheresoever the same shall be. In Witness Whereof I have herets set my hand this 13th Day of May A. D. 1889.

I, Mary S. Bordery of Absecon, Atlantic County, State of New Jersey, do hereby make the following codicil to my last will and testament dated May 13th, 1889.

First I revoke the legacy of Fifty Dollars given in my will to Susan B. Price and now give her in lieu thereof a promissory note for Two Hundred Dollars which I hold against her.

Second: My sister Susan T. Smith having departed this life I give the bequests mentioned in my will in her favor, to her grand children Sallie D. Bowen, and Susanna T. Bowen, said bequests being my sofa, carpet on the bed room and one work stand, and one half of the remainder of my household goods and furniture, except my extension table, as mentioned in my will, and which as therein stated are to be sold or divided by my executor therein named, and in all other respects I hereby ratify and confirm my said will. In Testimony Whereof I have herets unto set my hand and seal this 29th Day of December A. D. 1898.
