

Ninth: To my nephew George Thompson his heirs executors administrators or assigns, I do then direct my said Trustees to pay me eleventh share or part thereof.

Tenth: To my nephew Dennis Thompson his heirs executors administrators or assigns, I do then direct my said Trustees to pay me eleventh share or part thereof.

Eleventh: To my wife's sister Mrs. Beckie Tutz her heirs executors administrators or assigns I do direct my said Trustees to pay me eleventh share or part thereof.

Item: Should my sister Mrs. Sarah Utzin not survive the death or marriage of my wife or die me surviving, then at the death or marriage of my wife, or should my said sister survive the death or marriage of my wife and therefore become the recipient of the annuity, I have hereinbefore directed my Trustees to secure to her, then upon her death, in either event, the sum which I have herein directed my Trustees aforesaid to invest for her benefit, I direct them to divide into eleven equal parts and pay one part to each of the following named persons, viz: One part to my nephew Arthur Wrightson his heirs, executors administrators or assigns; one part to my nephew William Wrightson his heirs, executors administrators or assigns; one part to my nephew Henry Wrightson, his heirs, executors administrators or assigns; one part to my nephew George Tinley Junior, his heirs executors administrators or assigns; one part to my niece Mrs. Sarah Wittington her heirs, executors administrators or assigns; one part to my niece Mrs. Fanny Thompson her heirs executors administrators or assigns; one part to my niece Mrs. Emma App her heirs, executors administrators or assigns; one part to my niece Mrs. Mary Trigg her heirs executors administrators or assigns; one part to my nephew George Thompson his heirs, executors administrators or assigns; one part to my nephew Dennis Thompson his heirs executors administrators or assigns; and one part to my wife's sister Mrs. Beckie Tutz her heirs, executors administrators or assigns.

Item: And I hereby give to my said Trustees full power and authority to sell any or all of my real estate at private or public sale and invest the proceeds, or to lease the same as they may deem best for the interests of my estate.

Item: I nominate constitute and appoint my beloved wife Mary Jane Shirtcliff sole executrix of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills and testaments by me at any time heretofore made and do declare these presents to be and contain my

last will and testament. In Witness Whereof I the said Charles Shirtcliff the testator, have to this my last will and testament contained on four leaves of paper and to every leaf thereof, subscribed my name and to the last leaf thereof I have subscribed my name and affixed my seal this twenty-fifth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine, A.D. 1879.
