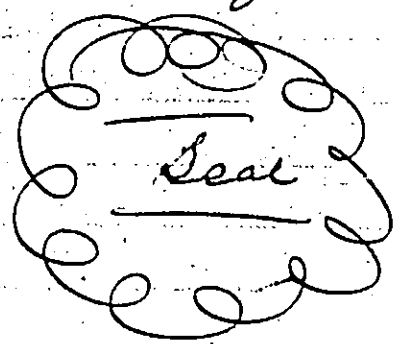


To all whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

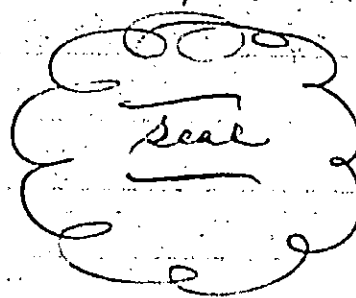

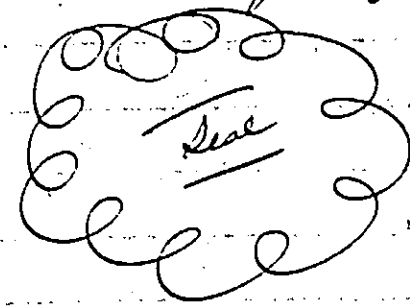
