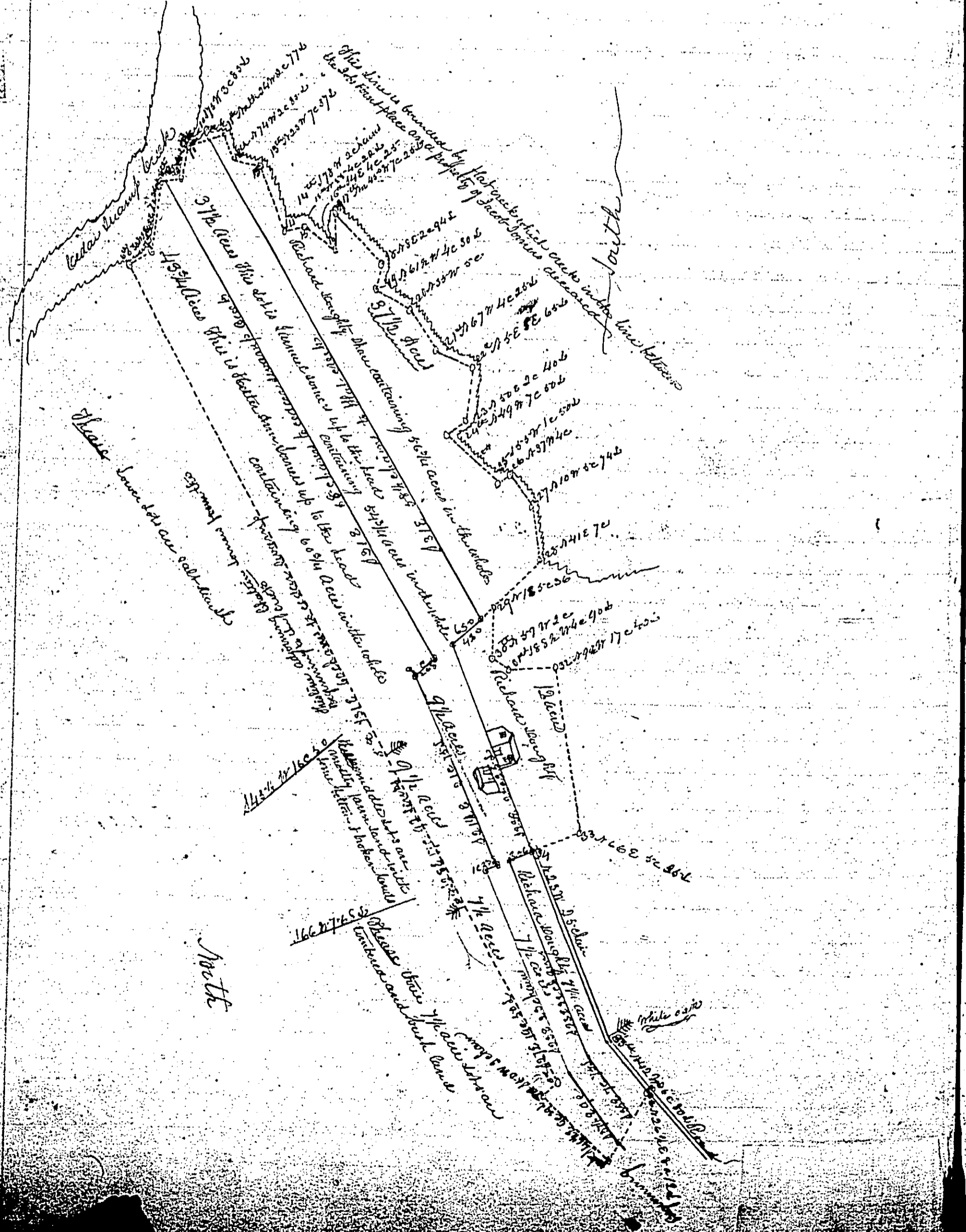


the lands in said application mentioned in the county aforesaid agreeably to said order and we have ascertained the metes and bounds of each share and owner share and proportion to be as follows that is to say First the metes and bounds of the share and proportion of Richard Sloughly is as is laid down on the map and marked his name containing 37 1/4 acres of Marsh 12 acres of upland and seven 7/8 acres of timber and bush land altogether making fifty six and three quarters acres and laid down on the south side of the map the metes and bounds of Samuel Somers is as they are laid down on the map being the middle share and marked his name on the same containing 37 1/4 acres of Marsh 9 1/2 acres of upland and seven 7/8 acres of timber and bush land making altogether fifty four and three quarters acres Next Ann Somers share is laid down on the north side of the map adjoining lands of Chatter Somers and marked by her name on the same containing 45 3/4 acres of Marsh 9 1/2 acres of farm land 7 1/2 acres of timber and bush land making altogether sixty and three quarters acres
