



West the most part of the way binding by a small Creek about  
fifteen chains and eighty links to the main Creek thence (3)  
binding the said Main Creek the several courses thereof to  
the Bank where said Creek is stopped thence (4) North fifty  
seven degrees West five chains to the tree first named and  
place of beginning containing about seventeen acres be  
the same more or less.

The Sixth Tract is a tract of wood land and bounded as fol-  
lows at a stake standing at an East corner of lot No. 31, and  
in the line of Thomas B. Iceland and runs first North seven  
chains and twenty five links to another stake for a corner  
of lot No. 32 thence in said line a West course about thirty  
eight chains to a stake standing by the side of the road in  
Elisha's old field thence - binding down said road a South-  
easterly direction the several courses thereof to the line of lot  
No. 31, thence in that line North seventy nine, one quarter  
degrees East about twenty two chains to the place of beginning  
containing about twenty five acres be the same more or less, the  
afore named tracts are set off by us as the one third part of said  
Richard Sculls decas. estate agreeable to the direction in said order  
given under our hands this eleventh 11<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. one  
thousand eight hundred and fifty five 1855
