Lots No. 5 & 16. Is set off to Lydia Scull wife of John S. Scull late Smith No. 5 Beginning at a stake on the North West side of the old River road leading past Robert Best and at the East corner of lot No. 4 and runs (1) North fifty five degrees West in the line of sd. lot twenty five chains and twenty links to Thomas Bevis line then (2) In sd. line North thirty one and a half degrees East one chain and seventy links to the corner of lot No. 6 thence (3) In the line of sd. lot South fifty five degrees East twenty five chains and seventy links to the road first named then (4) binding sd. road South forty six degrees West one chain and seventy five links to the place of beginning containing four acres and  $\frac{3}{100}$  of an acre more or less.

Lot No. 16. Beginning at the North corner of No. 15. in Judith Booy's line and runs (1) in sd. line North five degrees West five chains and forty links to the corner of lot No. 17 then (2) North eighty four and three quarter degrees East in the line of sd. lot eight chains and sixty six links to Mahlon C. Grambles line then (3) South five degrees West in his line five chains and fifty links to the corner of lot No. 15 then (4) in the line of said lot South eighty four and three quarter degrees West nine chains and forty two links to the place of Beginning containing five acres and forty hundredths of an acre more or less.

We now give the boundaries of Lots Nos. 8 & 17. which lots was by us set off to Alice Fox No. 8. Beginning at a stake standing on the North West side of the old River road leading up past Robert Bests and at the East corner of lot No. 7. and runs first North fifty five degrees West twenty six chains and seventy five links to Thomas Bevis line then (2) in his line North thirty one and a half degrees East in Bevis line two chains & fifty eight links to a stake at the corner of lot No. 9. then (3) in the line of No. 9 South fifty five degrees East twenty seven cha. and twenty five links to the road then (4) South forty six degrees West binding sd. road two chains and seventy five links to the place of beginning containing seven acres and  $\frac{2}{100}$  of an acre be the same more or less.

No. 17. Is the upper tract and lays adjoining the main River road & on the South side thereof. Beginning at a stake standing in the middle of the main river road and in the line of Japhet Ireland's land and runs first in the line South five degrees West four chains to a stake at the corner of lot No. 16. then (2) in said line South eighty four and three quarter degrees West ten chains and forty links to Judith Booy's line then (3) in her line North five degrees West four chains and nineteen links to the middle of the road first named then (4) North eighty four and three quarter degrees East in the middle of said road eleven chains and sixteen links to the place of beginning containing four acres and thirty seven hundredths of an acre be the same more or less.

Lots No. 7 & 18. was set off to Mary Smith wife of John B. Smith No. 7. Beginning at a stake set on the North East side of the road called the old River road leading up past Robert Bests and at the East corner of lot No. 6. and runs first North fifty five degrees West in the line of lot No. 6 twenty six chains and twenty links to Bevis line then (1) North thirty one and a half degrees East in Bevis line two chains

twelve links to the corner of No. 8. then (3) South fifty five degrees East in sd. line twenty six chains and seventy five links to the road first named then (4) South forty six degrees West by sd. road two chains and twenty links to the place of beginning containing five and  $\frac{5}{100}$  acres more or less.

Lot No. 18. Beginning at a stake in the centre of the road leading from Union Meeting House up to Joseph E. Smith's Mills and at the North corner of No. 17. and runs first North seven and a half degrees East three chains and fifty eight links to a corner of No. 19. then (2) North eighty four, three quarter degrees East eight chains and sixty six links to David Somers line then (3) in his South three quarters of a degree West three chains and fifty links to the road aforementioned then (4) South eighty four and three quarter degrees West in said road nine chains and twenty three links to the place of beginning containing three and  $\frac{15}{100}$  acres be the same more or less.

Lots No. 3 & 14. was set off to Ann English wife of Joseph English No. 3. Beginning at a stake on the North West side of the old River road and at the East corner of Thomas Lees land and runs first in Lees line North fifty five degrees West twenty four chains and forty links to Bevis line then (2) in Bevis line North thirty one and a half degrees East one chain and seventy links to the corner of lot No. 4. then (3) in the line of said lot South fifty five degrees East twenty four chains and seventy links to the road first named then South forty six degrees West by sd. road one chain and seventy five links to the place of beginning containing four and  $\frac{1}{100}$  acres more or less.

Lot 14. Beginning at a stake standing in Mahlon C. Grambles line at the East corner of No. 13. and runs first in the line No. 14. South eighty four and three quarter degrees West six chains and ninety four links to Judith Booy's line (2) in her line North five degrees West eight chains and ten links to a corner of No. 15 then (3) in the line of No. 15 North eighty four and three quarter degrees East eight chains and thirty nine links to sd. Grambles line then (4) in his line South five degrees West eight chains and twenty links to the beginning containing six and one quarter acres more or less.

Lots Nos. 1 & 13. was set off to Margaret Lee wife of Abel Lee No. 1. Is the lot whereon they now dwell and Beginning at the South West corner of Thomas Lees land and in Thomas Bevis line and runs (1) South thirty one and a half degrees West seven chains and eighty two links to a corner on the South West side of the road leading to Bevis Mills then (2) South forty eight degrees East in said road ten chains and eighty eight links to a stake for a corner (3) North forty four degrees East seven chains and ninety seven links to Thomas Lee line then (4) North forty eight degrees West in sd. line twelve chains and thirty five links to the place of beginning containing nine and one quarter acres more or less.

No. 13. Beginning at a stake standing in Mahlon C. Grambles line and at the corner of No. 12. and runs (1) in the line of No. 12 South eighty four & three quarter degrees West six chains and forty links to Judith Booy's line (2) in her line North five degrees West three chains and four links to a corner of No. 14. then (3) North eighty four, three quarter degrees East in the line of No. 14. six chains and ninety four links to said Grambles line then (4) in his line South five degrees West three chains and ten links to the place of beginning containing
