

to the new road thence (2) North fifty five degrees East along said road one chain and seventy five links to the line of the County Farm thence (3) South forty six and a half degrees East in said line twenty chains and ninety links to a corner of the widows wood land thence (4) Southwesterly direction one chain & seventy five links to the beginning containing three & $\frac{6}{100}$ of an acre more or less.

Lot No. 3, C. Is wood land Beginning at a stake standing in the line of Jonathan Risleys land and at the corner of lot 2. and extends first North one half a degree East in said Risleys line three chains and twenty five links to lot No. 4. thence (2) North eighty six and a half degrees East in the line of No. 4. fifteen chains and fifty links to the Susan Parsals line thence (3) In said line South one half a degree West three chains and twenty five links to the corner of lot No. 2. thence (4) South eighty six and a half degrees West in the line No. 2. fifteen chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing four acres and ninety six hundredths of an acre more or less.

No. 6, D. Is Meadow and is bounded as follows Beginning at a stake on the lower side of the old Bank and road and at Burn Risleys corner and extends first South forty six degrees and forty minutes East in Burns line about sixty two chains and fifty links to a stake in the lower line for a corner thence (2) South fifty five and a half degrees West one chain and fifty five links to the corner of lot No. 5. thence (3) North forty six degrees and forty minutes West sixty two chains and twenty links to a stake by the edge of the road and bank first named thence (4) North forty five degrees East along said road and bank one chain and fifty links to the place of beginning containing nine and $\frac{2}{100}$ acres more or less. The old Bank and Road is to be free for all the towns to use.

Jeremiah Risley Lots 1st Lot No. 3, A. Beginning at a stake in the lower line of Edward Risleys lot which his father deeded to him and at the corner of lot No. 2. and runs first South forty six and a half degrees East in the line of No. 2. twenty five chains and forty links to a stake set out side of the lower fence by the edge of the road thence (2) South forty five and a half degrees West along said fence one chain and seventy eight links to another stake by the side of the lane thence (3) North forty six and a half degrees West by the side of the lane fence twenty five chains and fifty links to the corner of Jeremiah's lot which his father deeded to him thence (4) North forty nine degrees East along said line & lot one chain and seventy seven links to the place of beginning containing five acres and $\frac{2}{100}$ more or less.

Lot No. 5, B. Is wood land Beginning at a stake and corner of lot No. 6, B. and in the line of the widows wood land and extends first Southwesterly course in her line one chain and eighty eight links to another corner it being a corner of lot No. 4, B. thence (2) North fifty six and a half degrees West in the line of said lot twenty one chains and twenty links to the new road leading up past Washington Adams thence (3) North fifty five degrees East along said road one chain & eighty eight links to the corner of lot No. 3.

thence (4) South forty six and a half degrees East in the line of No. 6. twenty one chains to the place of beginning containing three and $\frac{2}{100}$ acres more or less.

No. 2, C. Is wood land Beginning at a corner of lot No. 1, C. and in the line of Jonathan Risleys land and extends first North one half of a degree East in Jonathan's line three chains and twenty five links to a corner of Lot No. 3. thence (2) North eighty six and a half degrees East in the line of No. 3. fifteen chains and fifty links to a corner in the Susan Parsall line. (3) South one half a degree West three chains & twenty five links in said Parsals line to a corner of lot No. 1. thence (4) South eighty six and a half degrees West in the line of No. 1. fifteen chains and fifty links to the beginning containing four and $\frac{2}{100}$ acres more or less.

Lot No. 5, D. Is Meadow Beginning at a stake on the South East side of an old Bank and road and at the corner of lot No. 6. and extends first South forty six degrees and forty minutes East in the line of No. 6. about sixty two chains to the lower line - (2) South fifty five & a half degrees West one chain and fifty five links to the corner of No. 4. thence (3) in the line of lot No. 4. about sixty one chains and sixty links to a corner by the edge of the old bank and road thence (4) North forty five and a half degrees East along said bank and road one chain and fifty links to the place of beginning containing nine and thirty three hundredths acres more or less.

Evan J. Risleys Lot No. 4, A. Is on the shore road Beginning at a stake on the Southeast side of main shore road and on the South side of lane as now layd out and extends first South forty six and a half degrees East by the lane fence thirty chains and thirty links to a stake for a corner by the edge of the old bank then (2) South forty five and a half degrees West along said Bank one chain and sixty one links to a corner of lot No. 5. then (3) North forty six and a half degrees West in the line of No. 5. thirty chains and forty links to a stake by the shore road for a corner then (4) North forty nine degrees East along said road one chain and sixty four links to the place of beginning containing four acres and $\frac{2}{100}$ of an acre more or less.

Lot No. 4, B. Is wood land Beginning at a stake for a corner stands in the line of the widows woodland Lot and at the East corner of Lot No. 3 and extends first North forty six and a half degrees West in the line of No. 3. twenty one chains and fifty links to the new road by Washington Adams then (2) North fifty five (55) degrees East in said road one chain and sixty two links to a stake and corner of Lot No. 5, B. then (3) South forty six degrees and a half East in the line of No. 5. twenty one chains and twenty links to line of the widows wood lot then (4) Southwesterly course in her line one chain and sixty two links to the place of beginning containing three acres and forty five hundredths of an acre more or less.

Third Lot is No. 4, C. Beginning at a stake in the line of Jonathan Risleys lands and at the North corner of Lot No. 3. and extends first North one half of a degree East in Jonathan's line three chains and twenty five links to the corner of lot No. 5. then (2) North eighty six and a half degrees East in the line of No. 5. fifteen chains and fifty links to the line of Susan Parsals lands then (3) South one half a degree West in said line three chains and twenty five links to the place of beginning containing three and $\frac{2}{100}$ acres more or less.
