

at a stone for a corner on the Northeast side of the public road leading from Joseph to Englishes Creek and at the corner of the Protestant Church lot and extends first South fifty one and a half degrees East along said road three chains to another stake and corner of lot No 2, thence (2) North thirty eight and a half degrees East in the line of No 2 lot eight chains to a stake for a corner thence (3) North thirty five degrees East fifty four chains and ninety links to a stake in the road leading to Lion meeting house thence (4) South eighty five degrees West up said road six chains and sixty links to a turn in said road thence (5) North seventy four degrees West still up said road about five chains to a stone for a corner thence (6) South thirty five and a half degrees West thirty chains and fifty links to a stone thence (7) South thirty five degrees West seven chains and fifty one links thence (8) South forty six 46 degrees East seven chains and fifty four links to a stake thence (9) South forty degrees West seven chains and eight links to the place of Beginning containing fifty three acres be the same more or less

Second lot No 1, B. Wood land

This lot is wood land and is bounded as follows Beginning at the East corner of Nicholas Hickmans land which he purchased of said Somers deceased and extends first North forty seven degrees in the line of lands of John and William Jefferys thirty four chains and forty six links to a corner in the branch thence (2) North forty six degrees West in the line of Andrew B. Sculls lot six chains and thirty one links to David Lees line thence (3) South forty seven degrees West in Lees line thirty three chains and ten links to Joseph Hickmans line thence (4) South forty one and a half degrees East binding said line sixteen chains and thirty seven links to the place of beginning containing fifty five acres be the same more or less then ends the boundaries of Ann E. Blackmans

First lot No 2 A.

As follows Beginning at the South corner of Andrew Steekmans lot and extends first North two degrees East his line seven chains and sixty five links thence (2) North thirteen degrees East two chains and ten links (3) South seventy nine degrees East two chains (4) North twelve and a quarter degrees East three chains and fifty links (5) North fifteen degrees East fifteen chains (6) North forty three and one quarter degrees East eleven chains to the public road (7) South fifty one and a half degrees East along said road three chains and five links to a stake thence (8) South thirty eight and a half degrees West thirteen chains (9) South fifty one and a half degrees East two chains and forty links thence (10) South eighteen and three quarter degrees West twenty six chains to a corner on the side of the road thence

four and one quarter degrees West four chains and fifty one links to the place of beginning containing fifteen acres and $\frac{1}{2}$ of an acre be the same more or less. The second lot is wood land and is known by the name of the Ann Edwards tract Beginning at a stake in Daniel Lees line and extends first South three quarter degrees West twenty seven chains and ninety five links (2) South forty seven and three quarter degrees West eleven chains and fifty four links (3) North seventy six degrees West nine chains and twenty five links (4) North seventy seven and one quarter degrees West five chains and four links to a corner thence (5) South twenty four and three quarter degrees West twelve chains and ninety two links (6) North forty nine and one quarter degrees West eleven chains and twenty five links thence (7) North forty five and one quarter degrees East ten chains and twenty five links (8) North seventy nine degrees East nine chains and twenty seven links to the Marys Landing road thence (9) North one and one quarter degrees West along said road fifteen chains (10) North seventeen and one quarter degrees West still along said road nine chains and thirty seven links to a stake (11) North eighty two and a half East three chains and eighty links to a stone thence (12) North eighty degrees East twenty chains and eight links to the place of beginning containing sixty five acres be the same more or less. This is wood land known as the John Ireland tract Beginning at a stake in the road at the East corner of a lot John Chabon purchased of sd Ireland and extends first North forty five and one quarter degrees East thirty three chains and fifty links thence (2) North one degree East twelve chains to a corner thence (3) South fifty degrees and thirty eight minutes West twenty three chains and sixty links to a stone thence (4) South forty and one quarter degrees West twelve chains and twenty links to another stone for a corner by the side of the road leading to the upper mill thence binding the same (5) South fifteen and a half degrees East four chains and sixty two links (6) South five and a half degrees East three and a half chains (7) South thirteen degrees East four chains to the place of beginning containing thirty four acres be the same more or less.

Wood land No 2, C.

Called the two mile Swamp tract and Beginning at a stone set for a corner on the North side of the road leading to Lion meeting house and extends first North four and three quarter degrees East three chains and eighty three links to a corner at Smiths label thence (2) South
