

a half degree East thirty six links to a corner (3) North forty six and three quarter degrees west four chains to a stake and corner thence (4) North forty nine degrees East nine chains to the Risley line (5) South forty six and three quarter degrees East in said line eleven chains and thirty eight links to the fence thence (6) South forty nine degrees west two chains and fifty five links to a corner (7) South forty six and three quarter degrees East seven chains and five links (8) South forty nine degrees west three chains and twenty five links (9) South forty six and three quarter degrees East two chains and ninety five links to the Shore road thence (10) South forty nine degrees west three chains and fifty six links to the place of beginning containing sixteen chains of improved and wood land together the second lot is cleared land & bounded as follows Beginning at a stake standing along the lane leading to the meadow and at the South corner of lot No. 5 and extends first North forty nine degrees East eight chains and fifty five links to the Risley line thence (2) South forty six and three quarter degrees East in said line one chain and eighty four links to a corner (3) South forty nine degrees West eight chains and forty three links to a stake by the side of the lane thence (4) North forty six and three quarter degrees West up said lane one chain and eighty four links to the beginning containing one acre and fifty four hundredths of an acre more or less. Beginning at a corner at the bottom and in the line of S. Adams land extends first South forty six and three quarter degrees East in said line forty eight chains and twenty links to the Creek thence down the Creek the several courses thereof to the old thoroughfare thence (2) North seventy five degrees East two chains to the Risley line thence (3) North forty six and three quarter degrees West fifty seven chains and sixty nine links to the bottom of the field thence (4) South forty four and three quarter degrees West one chain and fifty links to the place of beginning containing eight and sixty five hundredths of acres be the same more or less. This ends the boundaries of the meadow above as afore stated given under our hands this tenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy one 1871.
