I hereby constitute my wife Clara G. Snellenburg and my brother Nathan Snellenburg the Guardians of the persons and Estates of my minor children.

I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Clara G. Snellenburg, my brother Nathan Snellenburg and my Cousin and partner Simon E. Block the Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I hereby authorize my Executors aforesaid and them empower, and the survivors and survivor of them to bargain and sell, either at public or private sale, all or any part of my Real estate when and upon such terms, and price as to them may seem fit and the same by proper deeds and assurances in the law to grant and convey to the purchaser or purchasers thereof in fee simple or for any less estate without any liability on the part of such purchaser or purchasers to see to the application of the purchase money.
