

appurtenances also all my oyster ground and oysters thereon, and all my boats and working tools also all the money I may die possessed of whether on my person, in my house or in bank subject however to the following bequest viz.

Third. I give and bequeath unto my grand son Raymond Hackett the sum of fifty dollars to be paid from my effects in ten annual payments of five dollars each, the same to be paid to his step-mother Annie Hackett to be expended in clothing for him and in case the death of said Annie Hackett before the expiration of said ten years then my son Frank Champion shall expend the said amount of five dollars per year for clothing for him the said Raymond Hackett until the expiration of said ten years.

Lastly I hereby appoint my son Frank H. Champion executor of my last will and testament with full power to sell at public or private sale any or all my property real, personal or mixed herein devised and to execute deeds or deeds therefor and to do all things lawful to carry out my last will and testament.
