

Sixth: Subject to the foregoing bequests and trusts I give and devise to my children and the survivor or survivors of them the whole of my estate, real and personal, to be paid and delivered to them upon the death or marriage of my wife, Roberta Comely.

Seventh: I hereby constitute and appoint my wife to be the executrix of this my last will, without bonds.

Eighth: I hereby give to my said wife as trustee and executrix full power and authority to sell and convey any and all of my real estate, at private or public sale, and to invest the proceeds or lease the same or any part thereof at her discretion.

Ninth: In case of the death of all my children prior to my wife's death without having been married and left no descendents, I direct and will that upon the death of my wife the sum of five hundred dollars be paid to the St. Francis Roman Catholic Church of Glasgow, Scotland, and the further sum of five hundred dollars to the Roman Catholic Church at Raphoe, County Donegal, Ireland, and one thousand dollars to St. Nicholas Roman Catholic Church at Atlantic City, New Jersey; and the residue of my estate to the Reverend Rector of the church last mentioned. All of the foregoing bequests to be used for masses for the repose of the soul of myself, my wife and children.
