of W. H. Ryan deceased.

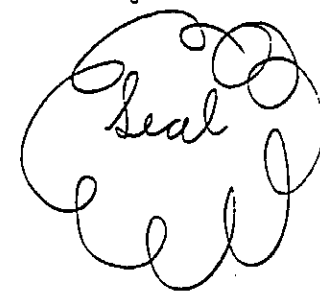
Application having been made to me by Sallie B.
