

3d. I hereby direct and empower my executors to make sure and prompt provision for the payments aforesaid, even if it should be necessary from time to time to make sale of some of the unimproved real estate for that purpose.

4th. all the balance of my property, real, personal, or mixed, that remains after the aforesaid bequests have been taken care of I give, devise and bequeath to my three sons, William Paton Thomson, Samuel Garver Thomson, and McLeod Thomson, share and share alike.

5th. I hereby appoint my wife, Emma G. Thomson, guardian of the person and estate of my son, McLeod in case he is still a minor at the time of my decease.

6th. I hereby nominate and appoint as executors of this my last will and testament my two sons, William Paton Thomson, and Samuel Garver Thomson.
