Item. All the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate of whatsoever kind and wheresoever situate I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto my eight children George Taulane, Edward H. Taulane, Lewis A. Taulane, Joseph H. Taulane, Rebecca Taulane, Annie Taulane, Clara Smith and Laura Taulane share and share alike in fee simple.

Item, I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint The Fidelity Insurance Trust and Safe Deposit Company Trustee and my four sons George Edward H., Lewis A., and Joseph H. Taulane Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness Whereof I George Taulane the Testator above named have to my last Will and Testament written on six pages of paper set my hand and affixed my seal this Twenty first day of October Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and ninety five (A. D. 1895).
