In the matter of the probate of the last will and testament of Jonathan C. Smith deceased.

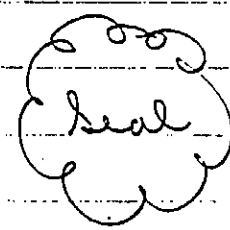
Application having been made to me by Mary C. Smith
