Sixteenth. I give my executors full power and authority to sell any or all my real estate at public or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as to them may seem advisable and to give good and sufficient deeds in law therefor.

Seventeenth. I hereby nominate and appoint the Guarantee Trust Company of Atlantic City and Jacob Silberman of Philadelphia, executors of this my last will and testament.
