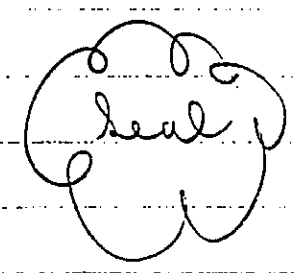
In the Matter of the probate of the
