"Will of Mary A. Dougherty"

In The Name of God, Amen: I, Mary A. Dougherty, widow of the late Charles J. Dougherty, of the City of Atlantic City, in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, make and publish this, my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills or codicils thereto heretofore made by me.

Item First: I direct all of my just debts and funeral expenses to be paid as soon as may be reasonable after my decease.

Item Second: To each of my grand-children, Nellie Murphy, Charles Murphy and Thomas Murphy, the children of my deceased daughter Mary Murphy, I give and bequeath the sum of One Dollar, I heretofore having expended upon them for their maintenance and education a sum equivalent to any sum my deceased daughter would have received as her distributive share of my estate had she survived me.

Item Third: It is my will that any advancements of gifts which I have made or may hereafter make to any of my surviving children hereinafter named shall be in addition to and not in satisfaction of the distributive share or any part thereof given them by this will.

Item Fourth: I direct and it is my will that my executors hereinafter named pay to the Reverend Father McShane of St. Nicholas Parish for masses for the repose of the souls of my deceased husband and myself the sum of Fifty Dollars.

Item Fifth: I give, bequeath and devise all the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal and mixed, whatever it may consist of, or wherever situate, to my children William Dougherty, Charles J. Dougherty, Ellen Reddy, Kate Small and Annie J. Branson, to be equally divided between them, share and share alike.

Item Sixth: I constitute and appoint my son, Charles J. Dougherty and my son-in-law, Howard J. Branson, co-executors of this my will and testament, and I direct that they be not required to give any bonds.
