trust for my son John T. Ewing, to pay him the net income of all the said real estate during his natural life and out of said income my said executors shall keep the said premises in good condition and repair and in the event of the death of my son John T. Ewing I give, devise and bequeath all the said real estate, devised as aforesaid to my said executors, to the children of my said son, John T. Ewing, share and share alike, their heirs and assigns forever.

Item: I appoint my wife, Matilda Ewing, guardian of all my minor children that I may leave at my death each of whom I will and direct shall be educated and maintained by my said wife, out of the said net income of my said property given, devised and bequeathed to her as aforesaid until each of my said minor children shall have attained the age of twenty-one years.

And I hereby appoint and constitute my said wife, Matilda Ewing and my son, Robert J. Ewing, executrix and executor of this my last will and testament and hereby repeal all former wills at anytime made by me.
