

Atlantic County Surrogate's Court

In the matter of the probate of the last will and testament of Newton J. Seely, deceased
Order for Probate

It appearing from the petition of Jonathan Lull Seely, filed herein, that Newton J. Seely, late of the Town of Hammonton, in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, died on the 1st day of December, 1908, and more than ten days ago, having first duly made and executed a paper writing purporting to be his last will and testament, in and by which he failed to name an executor thereof; and that Surrogate having given notice to the next of kin, inquired into the circumstances, taken proof, and being satisfied of the genuineness of the will produced, the validity of its execution, and the competency of the testator, and no caveat against the probate of said will having been filed and the said Jonathan Lull Seely being in my judgment a fit person to administer the estate of the said testator;

It is on this sixth day of July, 1909, adjudged that the instrument offered for probate in this matter is the last will and testament of the said Newton J. Seely, deceased, and the same is hereby admitted to probate, and it is ordered that Letters of Administration with the Will Annexed be issued thereon to the said Jonathan Lull Seely upon the giving by him of a bond as required by law.
