J., on which stands St. Andrew's Evangelical Lutheran Church, still stands in my name at the time of my death, then I direct my Executors to transfer the same to The Lutheran Mission & Church Extension Society to be held by it until the said St. Andrew's Church shall pay to the said Lutheran Mission & Church Extension Society the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars. When the title of the above mentioned property was vested in me I acted as Trustee for a congregation which, as yet had no corporate existence.

Item 8. If, at the time of my death I am still holding a mortgage for Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) on the property of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Magnolia, N. J. then I direct my Executors to transfer the same to the Lutheran Mission & Church Extension Society to be held by it until such time as the said Society may think proper to transfer it to the said Evangelical Lutheran Church of Magnolia, N. J. according to its best judgment as to terms & conditions.

Item 9. I give, devise & bequeath the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) to Laurel Hill Cemetery, Philadelphia, the income of which is to be used in keeping in proper order the burial lot in which have been interred the remains of my Uncle, William Ashmead, M. D., & of his wife, Nancy M. Dible Ashmead.

Item 10. I give, devise & bequeath the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to St. Michael's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Germantown, Philadelphia, Pa., the income of which is to be expended in keeping the following burial lots in proper order & condition: namely, (a) The lot of the late Rev. St. Schaeffer, D. D., (b) The lot of the late James Ashmead, & (c) The lot of the late Rev. Benjamin Feller. Whatever balance of the income of this sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) may be left after the above mentioned lots have been carefully & properly attended to in each year, may be applied or expended by the Vestry of the said St. Michael's Ev. Lutheran Church in such way as in their judgment may seem best.

Item 11. I give, devise & bequeath the sum of Fourteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,400.00) to the Theological Seminary of the Evangelical Lutheran Church at Philadelphia, & now located at Mt. Airy, the income

of which is to be used by the Faculty of the Seminary in assisting needy students of said Institution.

Item 12. I give, devise & bequeath to my dear wife, Elizabeth H. J. Schaeffer, the sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00), but I add this request, that she will make such disposition of it in her will that ultimately the principal will be paid to the Evangelical Lutheran Ministerium of Pennsylvania &

adjacent States, the income to be used in assisting aged, infirm, or needy ministers, their wives or unmarried daughters. If, however, my wife should elect not to accept the provisions of this my last Will & Testament, then this Item (No. 12) is to be considered as null & void - the bequest herein contained falls.

Item 13. In the year of our Lord 1901 my sister, Katherine C. Schaeffer, transferred to me, for good & sufficient reasons, property to the value of about Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for which I have paid her only interest, so that she has a claim on me for that amount. I therefore direct my Executors to transfer to the said Katherine C. Schaeffer or her lawful representative the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) either in real estate or in stocks & bonds, or both, as circumstances or their judgment may decide best.

Item 14. All the rest, residue & remainder of my property, real & personal, whatsoever & wherever it may be found I give, devise & bequeath to my dear wife, Elizabeth H. J. Schaeffer, during or for the term of her natural life, & after her decease I direct that it be divided between the following Institutions, Boards or Societies, share & share alike, namely (a) The Theological Seminary of the Evangelical

Lutheran Church at Philadelphia, Pa. & now located at Mt. Airy, Phila.

(b) Muhlenberg College, Allentown, Pa.  
(c) The Evangelical Lutheran Ministerium of Pennsylvania & adjacent States, for the use of its English Mission-work in the City of Philadelphia & its vicinity.

(d) The Lutheran Mission & Church Extension Society, whose headquarters are at present in Philadelphia, Pa.

(e) The General Council of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in North America, to be divided equally between its English Home Mission-work, its Foreign Mission-work & its work in Porto Rico or the West Indies. Provided however that my wife shall have the privilege of using or disposing of, according to her own will & pleasure, any of my property included in this Item (No. 14), except real estate, bonds, mortgages & stocks, & is not to be asked or expected to give any account or report thereof whatsoever. But if my dear wife Elizabeth H. J. Schaeffer, should decide to take her share of my estate, according to law then I direct that after she has received her share & all the bequests mentioned have been paid, the rest, residue & remainder of my estate shall be divided according to the directions above given, that is, to the various Organizations, Boards, Societies &c mentioned <sup>above</sup> in this Item (No. 14).

Item 15. I wish it to be understood by all interested
