in his solemn oath, did depose and say, - That he was well acquainted with Samuel Brady
and James Kennedy, the two subscribing witnesses to the foregoing last Will and Testament
of George H. Stuart, dated the eighteenth day of October, A.D. 1878, deceased, and is familiar
with the respective signatures of the said Samuel Brady and James Kennedy, having present
by him the same in their hands, as well as their names; and this deponent further says
that he has carefully examined the foregoing respective signatures of the said Samuel Brady
and James Kennedy, and verily believes the said signatures to be in their own respective
proper handwriting; and this deponent further says that the said George H. Stuart re-

did request the said Samuel Brady and James Kennedy, to subscribe their names to
