Stuart Patterson, of full age, being duly sworn according to law, and on being demanded, did before and say, — That he was well acquainted with Samuel Brady and James Kennedy, the two subscribing witnesses to the foregoing last Will and Testament of George H. Stuart, (deceased the eighteenth day of October, A.D. 1890) deceased, and is familiar with the respective signatures of the said Samuel Brady and James Kennedy, having known by seen them write their names, as well as other matters; and this deponent further says that he has carefully examined the foregoing respective signatures of the said Samuel Brady and James Kennedy and verily believes the said signatures to be in their own respective proper handwriting; and this deponent further says that the said George H. Stuart resided in the city and county of Philadelphia, in the state of Pennsylvania, and departed this life since the attestation of said will.

And this deponent further says that he was present at the time of the execution of said last Will and Testament and did stand near George H. Stuart, deceased, the testator therein named, sign, seal, publish and declare the same as and for his last Will and Testament, and that on the date thereof he, the said George H.
