Connelly, and do further direct that if my said grand children are removed from the care of my said daughters they shall receive nothing further from my estate except as provided in Section Two of this my last will and testament.

I, the said Sarah Jane Connelly, do hereby appoint as the Executors of this my last will and testament my beloved daughters Sida F. Connelly Dunlap and Bertha S. Connelly, and I hereby order and direct my said Executors not to file any appraisement of my estate and I hereby direct my said Executors to file no bond. And as my said Executors are also Trustees and Residuary Legatees of my said estate I beg them to use their good judgment, in making any just and reasonable provision for any of my children and grand children if it shall be deemed advisable in addition to what is set forth in the provisions of this will.

I hereby give to my said Trustees and Executors full power and authority to sell any or all of my real estate at private or public sale and to invest the proceeds, or to lease the same as they may deem best for the interest of my estate.

In the event of the death of one of my said Executors and Trustees I direct that the survivor shall have full authority over my estate, and shall have power to appoint her successor or successors by will or other instrument in writing.
