

to my nephews and nieces children of my sister Jette, namely Meyer Vorkhanger, Abraham Vorkhanger, Annie (inter-married with Moses Helleman), Sarah Vorkhanger and Rebecca Vorkhanger, share and share alike, for and during the term of their natural lives, and the life of the survivor of them. Should any of them die leaving children such children shall take the share that would otherwise be payable to their, his or her parent. No part of said income shall be at anytime subject to attachment, levy or execution for any debt due by either of said legatees; nor shall the portion of share of said income of either of them be sold, or hypothecated, under penalty of such share or portion forever ceasing and determining with the same force and effect as if such party were naturally dead. And from and after the death of the last survivor of them in further trust, to sell the said real estate and the proceeds thereof to part and divide equally to and among the children of them, my nephews and nieces aforesaid in this item enumerated, then surviving share and share alike, per capita and not per stirpes.

The said trustee of his ^{A. M. & Rechie} successors when the time arrives to make the conversion and distribution aforesaid, shall have full power and authority to sell at either public or private sale at the best price obtainable, and all necessary conveyances and assurances in the law to make effect and deliver, without any obligation on the part of any purchaser or purchasers to look to the application of the purchase money or any part thereof.

Item IX. I give and bequeath unto the following named institutions, located in the city of Philadelphia, the amount set opposite their respective names, that is to say:
 To the Jewish Hospital Association, Five thousand dollars.
 To the Jewish Maternity Association, Two thousand dollars.
 To the Jewish Immigration Society, Two thousand dollars.
 To the Young Women's Union, Two thousand dollars.
 To the Alliance Israélite Universelle, Two thousand dollars.
 To the Congregation Mikveh Israel, Five thousand dollars.
 Item X. I give and devise unto The Hebrew Education Society of the city of Philadelphia, the premises now occupied by me as a residence, situate No. 1529 North Seventh Street, said city, to hold to it and its successors in fee simple, forever, subject nevertheless to the condition that the same shall always be used, occupied and employed as a school appertenant to and in connection with the educational system of said society, and that when such occupation shall cease, or be discontinued the said premises and property shall revert to, merge into and become part and parcel of my residuary estate, and its descent shall be determined by the provisions herein contained respecting my residuary estate.

Item XI. I give and bequeath unto the following named persons the amount set opposite their respective names, that is to say:

To my nephew Ephraim D. Grechie, the sum of Five thousand dollars.
 To my niece Isabella (wife of my nephew Meyer D. Grechie) the sum of Three thousand dollars.
 To my nephew Meyer D. Grechie, the sum of Forty five hundred.
 To my niece Annie Pereya, the sum of Ten thousand dollars.
 To my nephew Richard Pereya, the sum of One thousand dollars.
 To my nephew Ernest Pereya, the sum of three thousand dollars.
 To my nephew Jules Pereya, the sum of Three thousand dollars.
 To my niece Annie Helleman, the sum of Five thousand dollars.
 To my niece Sara Vorkhanger, the sum of Five thousand dollars.
 To my nephew Meyer Vorkhanger the sum of Five thousand dollars.
 To my niece Rebecca Vorkhanger, the sum of Five thousand dollars.

To my niece Melina Sam, Two thousand dollars.
 To my niece Carrie Rothschild, Two thousand dollars.
 To my niece Carrie Finkler, Two thousand dollars.
 To my niece Annie Lazarus, Two thousand dollars.
 And to my executor, the sum of Five thousand dollars, to be by them invested and the income thereof to be paid to my nephew Abraham Vorkhanger, quarter yearly, during the term of his natural life, and at his death the principal to be divided as provided in Item VII hereof.

The legacies aforesaid to my nephews and nieces, Annie Helleman, Sara, Meyer, Abraham, and Rebecca Vorkhanger shall not be subject to attachment, levy or execution for any debt due by them or any of them and they shall have no power to anticipate, sell or hypothecate the same under penalty of the legacy to the party offending, ceasing and determining with the same force and effect as if the same had never been made.

The provisions herein as to these my nephews and nieces may seem harsh, but I desired that they alone shall be the beneficiaries of all I leave them and not that others may merchandise on their necessities. And I may here say for the benefit of those who may criticize my form of bequests or the amounts appointed to those who may have selected to enjoy my bounty, that this is my will and having thought of all my relations those omitted are purposely omitted. What I have is the result wholly of my own energies and I owe no obligation to anyone for assistance, and having no children I exercised the right of an American citizen to do with my
